Day 1

I can answer questions about a text

Read the extract from Harry Potter. Answer the questions on the sheet then get an adult to help you mark it.

Extension- You will probably have time for this!

Look at the picture of the castle. What are the main features? How do you know it is a castle? Draw (and colour if you wish) your own castle. Label at least 5 features of the castle and try to use some descriptive language (adjective + noun, simile, alliteration etc) like the ideas in the Harry Potter extract. E.g. two towering turrets, ancient ruins, rusted hinges...
