Reading/SPAG

Keep reading – make sure you are still reading regularly at home and fill in your Reading Diary as you go along.

As you read a book remember to answer some of the questions on the prompt cards provided.

Day 1

I can read and perform a poem.

Read the Performance Poem Fruit Picking. Poems are often like a song with a rhythm that carries you along. Tap the beat of the poem with one finger on your hand. Underline the rhyming words at the end of each couplet.

You are going to perform your poem to someone at home. How can you use your bodies to make a steady beat? You could click fingers, clap hands, slap knees etc. What instruments could you use? You could use a wooden spoon on a saucepan as a drum, rice in a box as a shaker. We would love you to film your performance and show us your final performance on ClassDojo!

Day 2

I can read and review a performance poem.

Read through the different poems. Did you notice that they are all raps? Highlight all the rhyming words and underline all the verbs that you can find.

Choose your favourite rap and review the poem using the task sheet provided.



Day 3

I can plan my own performance poem.

Read the poem **Question Time** by Michaela Morgan. Look at the rhyming words and highlight the nouns, adjectives and verbs. You are going to write your own performance poem based on the rhythm of a rap. The rap will be about a monster that you have made up!

Use the planning sheet provided to plan your rap. There is a blank planning grid if you would prefer to write a rap about a different subject.



Day 4

I can write my own performance poem.

Look back over the poem **Write-A-Rap Rap** that you studied on Day 2. Remind yourself of the rhythm it uses. Today you will write your own rap describing your monster using this rhythm. Look back over your plan you created yesterday before you start.

An example could be:

Hey everybody no need to fear,

My monster's here so let's all cheer.

He's sweet and friendly and fluffy too,

He loves to play and has invited you!

Day 5

I can edit and improve my performance poem.

Read back over your poem that you wrote yesterday. Check that it makes complete sense. Use a dictionary to help you spell any words you are unsure of. Copy up your poem in best using the sheet provided.


