Dear Parents / Carers

To support our history learning about the Stone Age and Iron Age, we will be taking the children on an exciting field trip this term.

CRANBORNE ANCIENT TECHNOLOGY CENTRE

Cranborne Ancient Technology Centre is a unique and very popular facility which provides hands on history - related experiences in an outside environment. The trip will adhere to the current government COVID guidance and risk assessments are in place. Each class will be spending a day at Cranborne to support our studies in class.

The visits will take place as follows:-

Wednesday 7 October	3SC
Thursday 8 October	3GF
Wednesday 14 October	3BB
Thursday 15 October	3DH

Children should arrive at school at their normal allocated times. However, in order to make the most of the activities on offer we are asking for them to be collected from school at **3.45pm**.

Please ensure that your child comes suitably dressed in **old** clothes as some of the activities will be messy. In order to comply with the Health and Safety requirements of the centre, please ensure that no fleeces or materials of a flammable nature are worn, and legs and feet should be covered, therefore no shorts, skirts, sandals or other open toed shoes. Sunhats / waterproofs should be provided where necessary. Any sun cream should be applied prior to bringing your child to school.

Children will need a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks, chocolates, sweets and no nuts, please) along with an extra drink and snack. PLEASE DO NOT BOOK A HOT MEAL for that day. If your child is entitled to free school meals, Harrison's will provide a packed lunch for the trip.

If you wish to help with this trip, please contact your child's class teacher.

We try to ensure that the children receive a variety of exciting learning experiences and some do naturally incur additional expense. To cover the cost of these visits we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £23.27 per child.

The breakdown of the cost for the trip is as follows:

Coach - £ 8.25

Methods of payment:

We always try to keep costs to a minimum but if insufficient contributions are received when requested, we will be unable to go ahead with the proposed activity. We will require your voluntary contribution to be paid by **Friday 25 September 2020**.

Should your child require medication on the day of the visit, please ensure that you have completed a yellow Administration of Medicine form and that you hand it to your child's teacher along with the relevant medication. Children with asthma will be responsible for their own inhalers.

In the event that you **do not** wish your child to take part in this activity, we would ask that you inform your child's class teacher in writing.
