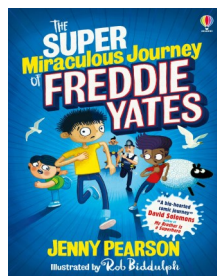

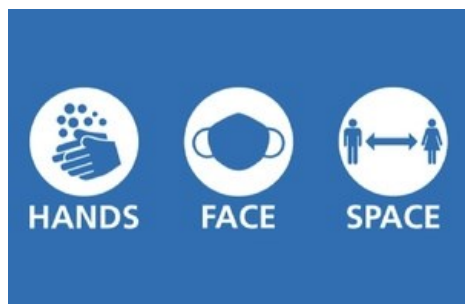
One of her neighbours has nominated her to go on Radio Solent this week and they have received a letter through their door asking for them to call and arrange this.
