PARENT CONSULTATIONS

Dear Parents/Carers,

The return to school has gone well and it is fantastic to have pupils energised, focused on their learning and enjoying breaktimes with their friends.

Now this step has been made, it is important that we provide an opportunity for you to meet virtually with your child's teacher before the Easter break. We would therefore like to invite you to parent consultations virtually on the following dates:-

Thursday 25 March 2021	5:00pm – 7:30pm
Tuesday 30 March 2021	3:30pm – 6:00pm

In these meetings, class teachers will share with you how your child has settled back into school routines and how they are progressing with their learning. It is also an opportunity for you to share with us anything you think would be useful for the class teacher to know. This might be information about how your child is managing life back in school, friendship groups, emotional wellbeing or a chance to ask questions about the final term of the academic year.

Appointments can be made online from 08:30 on Thursday 18 March 2021

The online booking system will close at 3pm on Thursday 25 March 2021.

We can only offer one appointment per child however there is now an option to invite another parent/guardian to your appointment. Instructions on how to do this are attached to the email.

Mrs Curry (SENDCo) will be available on both evenings for telephone consultations only. Please phone the school office if you wish to make an appointment.

If you would like to book an appointment with Mrs Cowling (Pastoral Care Worker), please email office@cjsdorset.org and Mrs Cowling will arrange a date with you for a telephone consultation.

A short guide on how to book appointments is included with this letter. To log in, you will need to enter your own details and those of your son/daughter – all of which must be as they are registered with the school (including your primary email address, their forename and date of birth). If you do encounter issues when attempting to log in, please double-check all details very carefully before contacting us for support if required.

Each appointment will last 6 minutes and please be aware that after this time the appointment will automatically end. If you miss your appointment, unfortunately there will not be an opportunity to rearrange it on the same evening. You will need to contact school the next working day. We recommend that you access the website and your appointment slot a few minutes ahead of schedule, as the appointment will begin automatically which means if you are a few minutes late, this will come out of your allocated appointment time.

On the evening itself, all appointments will take place via video and there is no need to attend the school site. Again, a short guide on how to carry out these appointments is attached. We recommend that you and your son/daughter attend these appointments together.
