Reports to Parents and Carers 2021-22

Today you will be able to access your child's report through the Arbor parent portal. Should you have any problems with accessing the report then please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

This report provides you with an overview of how your child is progressing in school. Each term a report will be shared with you and in the Spring term we will be holding online parent consultations with you once again. This is a part of our commitment to report more regularly. Included in this report is a comment from the year group leader and from Mr Fuller. In the summer term there will be a teacher comment about the year. This will be a more personalised message about your child's development.

Attendance figures

The report provides you with details about attendance from the beginning of the autumn term. Each session is either a morning or an afternoon, so a whole day equates to two sessions.

Teacher judgements

The report will show teacher judgements regarding how your child is achieving with their learning in each subject.

These teacher judgements are informed by the day to day progress of your child in class, observations from marking and feedback from assessments.

You will also see a teacher comment for reading, writing and mathematics along with a next step target for your child to focus on in the spring term.

There are three teacher judgements linked to our school values of 'Belonging, Achieving and Growing', which you will have read about on our school website and in recent newsletters. These values are discussed and referred to regularly with the children during lessons and assemblies.
