ATHLETICS COMPETITION

We recently took a team of 28 pupils from CJS to compete in the Bournemouth Town Sports Athletics competition. It was a fantastic day, and we had the following success stories: Adam in 4PG, came in second place in the Year 4 Boys Long Jump, with an impressive jump of 3.24m, only 0.11m behind the winner!
