The Christchurch Junior School team that played in the Participation Trophy were unlucky in their two matches against Baden Powell and St Katharine's, but progressed to the 3rd/4th place play-off. In the 3rd place play-off the captain switched the batting pairs around, we did a little better, but we lost focus in the last few overs. The opposition then scored a few boundaries so we came 4th overall. All the players that were new to cricket did very well for their first time. Unfortunately, they did not win any medals.

The fielding was so good that our team only needed 18 runs when stepping up to bat. We bowled very well and a lot of our wickets were taken by new comers. Starting off strongly with our batting, we began to overtake the opposition's score but they then overtook us by taking a few wickets. We a few boundaries towards the end, we won the match. We clinched the title with a score of 80-46. This team were awarded medals and the captain lifted the trophy.
