Dear Parents / Carers

This week we have taken part in a peer review with colleagues from a range of local schools joining us to help evaluate our approach to interventions. We have two dedicated intervention teachers (Mrs Sekhar and Mrs Holloway) who meet with dozens of children throughout each week, supporting them with learning. This can be for a number of reasons: helping children learn and embed their phonics knowledge using Little Wandle; supporting children to get to the expected standards in reading, writing and maths; enabling pupils to go beyond the expected standard for their year group. I am pleased that our reviewers identified many strengths in our approach as well as making excellent suggestions for our next steps.

We are very flexible with our intervention groupings, with children flowing in and out of these sessions as and when they require the support. If you ever have any queries about how this works, please do get in touch with the class teacher who will be happy to explain further.



COME AND JOIN THE BIKE BUS!

YEAR 5 COOKERY WORKSHOPS

In Year 5 this week, we have been very fortunate to have the CFFET (Christchurch Food Festival Education Trust) come and visit us to host a workshop for each class.

They brought in two different local head chefs to demonstrate how to make healthy recipes at home and then provided the children with tasting opportunities. The children were also able to develop their cookery skills through hands-on preparation; learning how to safely use a knife and then apply different chopping techniques to a range of vegetables.

The last part of their workshop involved them estimating the amount of sugar in products that they see at the supermarket. It was rather eye-opening to discover that presumably 'healthy' cereal bars contained more than 5 cubes of sugar in just one bar!

Following the workshop, the children were very excited and had commented: *"I LOVED this morning, that was so much fun!"* and, *"The salmon we had tasted really nice!"*. We were so proud of how the children conducted themselves and at how open they were to trying new things. It was lovely to see them all so engaged by the various aspects of the workshop. We are very much looking forward to hearing about how they got on with trialling some of the recipes at home.
