### THE BEST FOR ALL—THE BEST FROM ALL

Dear Parents / Carers

Time to give you a little more detail about the items which will make up our new uniform from September 2023 onwards, with images to follow next week. Remember, this uniform will be available for next year, as and when your child needs the next size, but it will not become compulsory until September 2024.

Formal uniform	Rationale
White shirt – collar, cuffs, buttons, short or long sleeved (not a polo shirt). 	Both the pupil and parent consultations were clear that it is time to retire the current branded, gold polo shirt. The replacement is a white shirt which can be easily purchased from a range of retailers, including supermarkets, and at a much more reasonable price. A white shirt is a smarter alternative, more in line with other local schools.
Tie 	The tie will complement the white shirt, ensuring that CJS pupils are smartly dressed and ready for success. The tie will match the colour of the school jumper.
Maroon V-neck jumper – branded with new logo  (Image next week!)	This smart V-neck jumper (woven cotton/acrylic) will complement the shirt/tie combination, and stay true to our current colours. It will have a distinctive gold line tracing the shape of the V-neck – a nod to our gold polo shirt. We are moving away from the 'jersey' style jumper.  This jumper will also hold our new logo, which has been selected after careful consideration and with the help of the pupil consultation.
Grey trousers/shorts/skirt/pinafore  Optional red/white checked summer	No change. As we currently have at CJS, these items can easily be purchased from many local shops and online. Children and guardians can choose which item they would like to wear.  Our summer dress has always been optional; children are very welcome to continue wearing their existing uniform all year round.
Black shoes	No change. Children must not wear white socks, socks with patterns or colourful socks. We will be strictly requiring all pupils to wear grey socks/tights.

<p>PE/Games T-shirt – branded with new logo</p> <p>(Image next week!)</p>	<p>This maroon t-shirt will be branded with our new school logo, giving a consistent appearance.</p>
<p>Plain black shorts or joggers</p> <p>Plain black sweatshirt</p> 	<p>We are insisting upon these generic black items being PLAIN to enable uniformity. We will not be allowing any branded items. E.g. clothing which depicts sports teams, logos which signify particular brands, items with stripes etc.</p> <p>The branded maroon fleece is being phased out to allow families to buy a generic black top for warmth during outdoor PE / Games.</p>
<p>Trainers</p> <p>Plain white sports socks</p>	<p>No change. Again, a consistent approach with items easily purchased at a range of retailers at a reasonable price.</p>

However, like all change, moving across to something new can feel daunting. We also recognise, that for a very small number of pupils, there may be some reasonable adjustments required, and we will work with families on a bespoke basis to make appropriate arrangements.
