Regular attendance at school is compulsory. It is vital for your child's academic success and social development. Attending regularly gives children continuity in their learning. It can be really tricky to catch up on missed learning due to absence and often children will feel anxious about this. Did you know that if your child has attendance of 90% they are on track to miss approximately 20 school days/4 weeks during the year? Over four years, that is more than a term out of school!
