Dear Parents/Carers

The safety of our pupils and community is my top priority, and this includes online safety. In September, the release of Keeping children safe in education - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk) 2023 edition specifically referenced the way in which schools filter and monitor devices which are online. We have selected Smoothwall | Education | Digital Safeguarding Solutions to enable us to fulfil the 'monitoring' requirement on all our devices. This system exists to help keep our children safe in their digital lives and alerts our CJS Designated Safeguarding Leaders (DSL) when access to inappropriate content is sought or where keystrokes are not acceptable (keystrokes are literally the letters/numbers/characters that children type). This means school staff can then support and educate children to keep themselves safe; we also engage the parents/carers when we have any concerns.

Of course, understanding that there is this level of monitoring in school can lead children to experiment out of school on personal family devices. I urge you to be fully aware of the content your children are accessing or attempting to access when not in school. If you need any help or support, please do not hesitate to get in touch with any of our DSLs: me, Mr Croton and Mrs Sykes.


Coming up over the next few weeks are a few events run by parents for our children to get into the Christmas Season with bang!! Please come and get involved.




Christmas Fun Day & Elfridges (Gifts4Giving) 8th December


During the day the children enjoy some funfair style games in the hall, whilst also having the opportunity to buy some £2 gifts for loved ones (humans and pets!)
