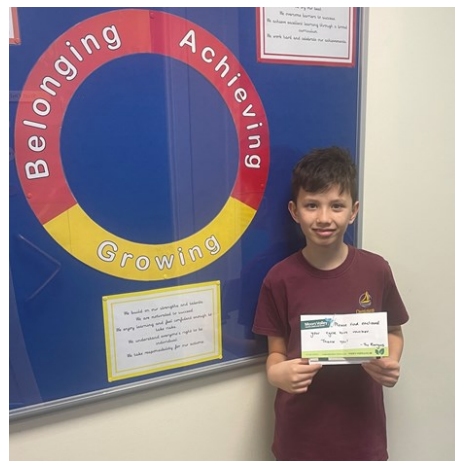
YEAR 3 MUSICAL PERFORMANCE TO PARENTS

Twynham Learning are seeking to appoint Clerks to the Local Advisory Boards (governance) at our primary and secondary schools.

The exception would be for fixed meeting dates and times, which will be either at the relevant school site or remotely via MS Teams.
