It has been another busy week at CJS!

Thank you to all the staff who have organised these events and well done to the children who took part.

We continue to work relentlessly in school on embedding the Twynham Learning Behaviour Curriculum. Our children have risen to the challenge and have made great progress with their behaviour for learning during lessons, when moving around the school and when returning to classrooms after break and lunchtime. The next step is for our children to recognise the importance of INTEGRITY – “Doing the right thing even when no-one is watching;” We would encourage you to reinforce this message at home, highlighting the importance of good behaviour at all times.

For the launch of Sustrans Big Walk and Wheel, the Year 4 children took part in some cycle skills on the playground. The children had great fun playing games and practising their skills of signalling, looking over their shoulder and using their brakes effectively.

CROSS COUNTRY

On Tuesday evening Mr. Harris and Mr. McClafferty took 15 keen runners to The Grange School for the first inter-school cross-country competition. It was a fantastic event with Year 5 and 6 running 2 km, and Year 3 and 4 running 1.5km. Everyone put in maximum effort, resulting in CJS becoming overall team winners and achieving Gold!

There were some brilliant individual efforts, most notably Harry (3GD) taking gold in the Year 3 and 4 boys' race with a time of 3:08, closely followed by Sam (3SC) taking silver in the same category with 3:10.

Mya (4AL) did amazingly, coming second in the Year 3 and 4 girls' race with a time of 3:15. Lilly's (6DB) time of 7.05, put her in bronze medal position in the Year 5 and 6 girls' race. Overall, a superb team effort with every participant showing determination to get over the finish line and demonstrating great sportsmanship by cheering on their team mates from the side lines.
