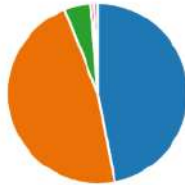
The children have settled back into school really positively this week, ready for a busy term ahead.

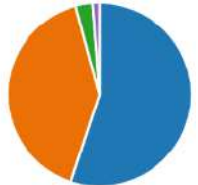

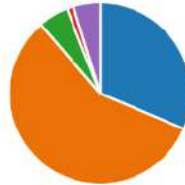

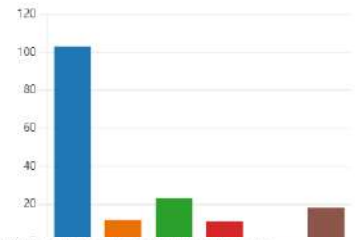

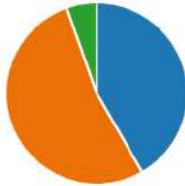

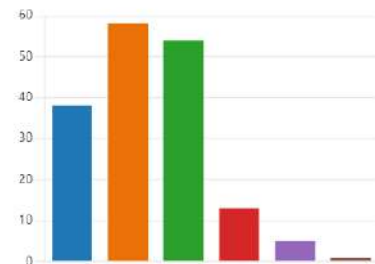

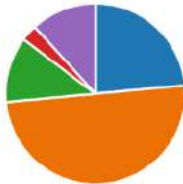

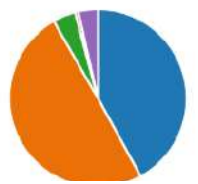

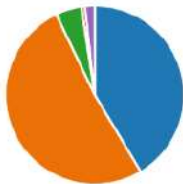

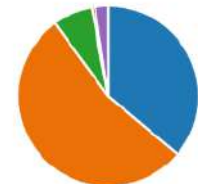

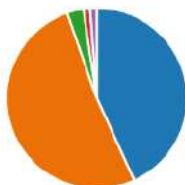

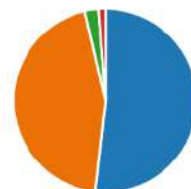

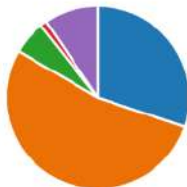

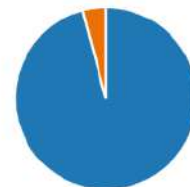
